Grading scheme

Breda University of Applied Sciences (BUAs) grades performances using a 1-to-10 system, where 10 is the highest possible mark. The student's Grade Point Average (GPA) will be included in the list of marks to represent the student's performance compared to international standards. The GPA is determined by taking the weighted average of the result obtained within the curriculum. The GPA is expressed on a scale from 1 through 4, to two decimal places accurately.

For details of how the system relates to international grades (ECTS grades) and to the GPA, see the table below.

A complete conversion table (from weighted average to GPA) is available on the BUAs website. Grade Point Average is 2.43.
