3. Short Course Descriptions

The student will successfully complete the following courses:

Sustainable Strategic Business Design (23 ECs)

The course **Sustainable Strategic Business Design (23ECs)** is a third year subject that is concerned with the essence of experiences and their design to pave the road for sustainable development in our industries and wider society. It leans on knowledge developed in core subjects of previous years, such as finance, economics, marketing, business law and ethics, organizational behaviour, management information systems and investigative abilities and integrates and further develops them into sustainable strategic business design using design thinking methods. This is accomplished through research, debates, decision making and generating new and innovative approaches in our industries.

- o **English (3 ECs):** Academic and Business English, both oral and written.
- o **Management Development Programme (2 ECs):** workshops and training sessions with regards to professional leadership, steering a professional career, influencing co-workers and personality traits.
- o **Preparation Graduation (2 ECs):** The preparation graduation course is designed to help students prepare for their graduation year. During the course student will be made aware of Moreover, they will develop an initial idea on how to shape and prepare (for) their graduation year.
- o **Bachelor Thesis (30 ECs):** It covers the following topics: General process overview and process accountability; Introduction; Literature Review; Objectives and Research questions; Methods of Research and Analysis. These topics are expected to be covered in the bachelor thesis report.

Dresscode

Sibelicious

The programme boasts its own training facility, called Sibelicious, in which students are given operational duties. The following areas are part of Sibelicious:

- Reception hall with reception desk
- Service desk
- Executive meeting rooms
- Board room
- Catering facilities for staff and students Food Court
- Restaurant
- Kitchen
- Grand Café
- Food Lab

Sibelicious enables first year students to gain experience in taking overall charge of a hospitality business under the guidance of a management team of second year students. This means that students are responsible for generating new business, making price quotations, organising meetings and events, pre production and retrospective costing and after sales. It goes without saying that the institute is ultimately responsible for monitoring the quality of the students' performance and for coaching the students who work in Sibelicious.

Through the <u>Portal</u> you can enter your e-mail account (add tile: BUas), Cum Laude Learning (add tile) and Osiris (add tile). Cum Laude Learning and Osiris are the two most important applications for students of Breda University of Applied Sciences.

Cum Laude (LMS) is the electronic learning environment of BUas. It is used for, for instance:

- * Course information: course descriptions, assignment descriptions, etc.
- * Hand-in assignments
- * Information on examinations: exam schedule, exam regulation, exam room division etc.
- * General information: year planning, curriculum information, regulations, etc.

Osiris is a student monitoring system in which your academic progress, such as your marks and ECTS, are monitored.

MyBUas App

'MyBUas'. This student app provides mobile access to information about your study schedule/ roster, marks, and BUas news. The app is compatible with Android (PlayStore) and iOS (AppStore).

Additional Costs

The principle of student exchange implies that students can study one semester at a partner university, while paying tuition fee at the home university. No additional costs will be charged, with the exception of school related activities that are not included in the tuition fee.

For the introduction days an extra € 135 will be charged for the participation in the so-called → InterSib 2020. That is including two overnight stays and full board (only in case you would like to participate).
