How to use text materials on Cumlaude/LBS
in 4 steps

1 Material Check

Check if the material (book, journal article etc.) you want to use, is online available via the Library
If it is available, please use the link to this material on Cumlaude/LMS.
How can you check availability? Use the Metasearch tool on the library website or ask for help via CIP@buas.nl.
If your material is not available at the library, please proceed to step 2

2 Short or long citation

Check if the material you want to use is a short or long citation. Guidelines for this are available on www.buas.nl/library, choose option: Copyright.
Not sure if it is a short or long citation? Ask for help via CIP@buas.nl

3 Is it a short citation?

Then you can publish the material on CumLaude/LMS.
Not sure if it is a short citation? Ask for help via CIP@buas.nl

4 Is it a long citation?

Then ask for permission by registering it at the Library/CIP website.
www.buas.nl/library
Is permission granted? Then you can publish the article on CumLaude/LMS.

Please note: permission for using materials is only valid for one year! But the library will send you an email when your permission is about to expire.
