Course content	The main project is a self-recruited assignment you will work on both individually and with your project group. The focus in this project is designing a process of solving a problem of a real client with the involvement of other parties (stakeholders). These parties need to be mapped, analyzed and activated. This semester has been organized according the principles of Design Thinking. The most important difference with a more traditional approach is that you work with loops instead of fully finished phases that lead to predefined products, i.e. you will follow a more individual trajectory. In the Deep dive we will pay special attention to the important stakeholder groups from the public and NGO sector. By means of workshops you will discover what they entail and how they should be seen in the bigger picture of Stakeholder Management. You will work on a specific case to obtain these
