

Second modern foreign language required

As the Academy of Hotel Management has the right to select all its students, all applicants* must fulfill the requirement of having studied a second modern foreign language (2e mvt).

If a second modern foreign language is not included in your current study programme, you will have until July 1 to meet the language requirement by enrolling in a language course elsewhere.

Meet the language requirement

If you are currently not studying French, German or Spanish in your secondary school programme, you will need to develop your skills in one of these languages by enrolling in a language course elsewhere in order to prove your competence at entrance level.

However, if you have not yet met our 2nd language requirement when the selection procedure is underway, you may still take part in this selection procedure under the condition that you can show proof of enrollment and will, thus, formally meet the admission requirements before the 1st of July. If you do not send the proof of enrollment, you may not take part in the selection procedure.

Once you have completed the language course and obtained the certificate, send it to Breda University of Applied Sciences hotelmanagement@buas.nl

Do note, however, that Academy of Hotel Management only accepts certificates issued by officially recognized language institutes in the Netherlands. The required level is equivalent to the secondary school end-levels (i.e. havo 5).

The certificate must explicitly state a level specification for the four language skills: reading, writing, speaking, listening. Only upon receipt of the certificate, will you formally meet the admission requirements.

The required levels correspond to the Common European Framework (CEF) of Languages as follows:

- French (B1)
- German (B1)
- Spanish (A2)

Recommended language institutes are:

- Goethe Institute (German)
- Alliance Française (French)
- Cervantes Institute (Spanish)
- or Babel languages

*Please mind that all applicants need the 2nd modern language, therefore we also focus on this 2nd modern language during the selection day for applicants with a vocational diploma (mbo 4). The same applies for applicants that enters the procedure via the 21+ arrangement!!
